The local base contest is the preliminary part of the sixth Annual Air Force Worldwide Family and Teen Talent Contest. The Air Force Services Agency sponsors the contest and is part of the Nell Buckley Performing Arts Series.

"Everyone is invited - moms, dads, sisters and brothers to sing, dance and perform together in this family-oriented event," said Robert Richert, Gunter Youth

Center director. "This has always been a fun evening of entertainment as well as a chance to cheer on your co-workers, friends and neighbors."

Contestants have the opportunity to act, sing, dance, and perform comedy routines or play musical instruments. Winners of the local contest will be videotaped and submitted for Air Force-level competition. Air Force level winners will receive certificates of achievement and U.S. Savings Bonds.

Contestants will perform in one of six categories: Parent and child; Husband and wife; Children - ages three to eight, pre-teens, ages nine to 12, teens, ages 13 - 18 and family. A panel of judges reviews entries in the local and Air Force Family Talent contests. The acts are judged on technical excellence, showmanship and treatment and interpretation of material.
