

National Security Forum (NSF) Guests' Frequently Asked Questions

The following questions are frequently received by the NSF staff. This list is by no means all inclusive and the NSF staff will be glad to answer any questions or assist in any way. Email is the best way to contact us at awc.nsf.workflow@us.af.mil.

Invitations/Registration

Q: When should I receive my emailed invitation and/or registration package for the NSF?

A: Invitations to the NSF nominees are generally sent by the end of February, and will include instructions to register on the NSF website. Registration should be complete NLT 1 April, so that we may finalize arrangements for lectures, lodging, meals, etc.

Guest Travel Arrangements

Q: When should I plan to arrive and depart the base so I can make my travel arrangements?

A: The NSF begins on the 9 May at 8:00am. Your registration packet and room key will be located at the lodging office (like a hotel check-in, open 24 hours). We recommend you arrive on Monday the 8th anytime. You could also arrive on Sunday if you want some free time in Montgomery or very early Tuesday morning (if you are driving). The Montgomery airport (MGM, also known as Dannelly Field) is only 15-20 minutes away, Birmingham Airport is 1.5 hours away. The NSF will end Thursday evening after dinner around 8pm, and most guests depart Friday morning.

Q: I plan to come a day or two before the conference (or leave a day or two later). Will I still have transportation to the base, and lodging?

A: No. There is a taxi at the airport that can get on base or you can try your host.

Q: Do you have a physical address for the Maxwell Blvd Gate Entrance? I'd like to use my GPS, and it can't find Maxwell AFB.

A: An address for the lodging office works best: 450 North LeMay Plaza, Maxwell AFB, AL 36112.

Q: Will I need a rental car during the NSF week?

A: No, you should not need a rental car. Transportation is provided to and from the airport and to all NSF events during the forum. However, you will need a rental car if you fly into Birmingham or Atlanta (instead of Montgomery) or if you choose to stay downtown or with someone in the local area and your host does not provide transportation to the base.

Lodging

Q: Will we have e-mail access at our lodging?

A: Each room has an Ethernet connection (wire provided) for Internet use.

Q: What happens if I arrive late?

A: If you arrive very late at night, and your escort is not available, your welcome packet and room key will be located at the lodging office when you check in. If you arrive after NSF has started, please notify NSF staff and your host to see if he or she can assist you.

Q: Do I need to make lodging reservations?

A: No, we will make lodging reservations for you on the base. You do not have to stay on the base if you are driving locally or would prefer to stay downtown. If you stay off base, you will need to have daily transportation to/from the base. Please let us know if you have any special requirements or limitations.

Q: What are lodging rooms like?

A: Lodging is similar to a basic hotel...not upscale, but comfortable--rooms include a queen bed, refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, Internet, and cable TV (no premium channels). Unfortunately, there are no king beds available on base.

Guest Registration

Q: When will I receive my Registration Package?

A: We will be sending out registration website instructions with the invitation. This package will give you more information on the specifics of the NSF and require you to input your travel plans, choices for lunches and also your registration payment.

Q: I don't have my travel plans ready to send you. Can I do part of the registration now and send/complete the rest later?

A: Yes. For online registration you may complete it in parts as you have the information.

Q: What are your gift shop hours during NSF?

A: The gift shop will be open 1000-1300 Tuesday -Thursday.

Activities

Q: What are the dress requirements?

A: The dress is everyday casual business/work attire. The AWC building is air conditioned and can be chilly at times. Attire for the Commandant's Reception and

Garden Party are dressy casual (no jeans or shorts). Temperatures in Montgomery average in the low 80's in May.

Q: Will I have any free time to explore Montgomery?

A: The agenda for the NSF will be published to the website soon. Once NSF starts at 0800 Tuesday morning, you will have very little free time. Monday afternoon when you arrive on the 9th or Friday morning after the NSF might be good times to explore.
