Airpower





Airpower, more than any other factor, has shaped war in the 20th century. Van Creveld portrays the rise of the plane as a tool of war and the evolution of both technology and strategy. However, the end of airpower's glorious age is drawing near. Airpower has

never been very effective against terrorists, guerrillas, or insurgents. As the warfare waged by these kinds of people grow in importance, airpower is losing utility almost day by day.

Global Airpower provides insight into the evolution of airpower theory and practice by examining the experience of six of the world's largest air forces (UK, US, Israel, Russia, India, and China) and of representative smaller air forces in Pacific Asia, Latin America,
