The following clothing items are "authorized" and "recommended" issue for students attending AMS. It does get cold in Alabama, ALL coats are mandatory (During winter months, OCT - MAR). Questions concerning clothing issue items prior to arriving at AMS will be addressed by unit supply representatives, not AMS personnel. Sunglasses (TO INCLUDE TRANSITION LENSES) will not be allowed to be worn during training while at the Academy of Military Science.

ITEMS RECOMMENDED FOR ALL STUDENTS: (Student may have to purchase items on this list)

2 white wash cloths
 Black ball-point pens
 Clothes brush or lint remover (lint roller)
 Small flashlight with batteries
 Laundry bag and laundry soap
 Lock (key or combination)
 Pajamas
 Personal Hygiene, Toiletry items
 Running/workout shoes
 Shoe polishing supplies (if needed)
 Shower shoes
 Soap dish with cover (optional)
 Undershirts (2 additional T-shirts: desert sand)
 For wear with Blues: functional badge(s), ribbons (state & federal), name tag (Mandatory)

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

Sewing kit & scissors
 Second pair of boots for field training (strongly encouraged)
 Bug spray
 Sunscreen
 Work gloves (Black or Sage Green for use in the field)

COLD WEATHER GEAR (Oct - Mar) for winter months to include:

Watch cap, Sage Green, no logo (MANDATORY)
 Gloves, Cold weather, Black or Sage Green (MANDATORY)
 Green Fleece, May be worn under APECS only (MANDATORY)
 Thermal insulated underwear (OPTIONAL)

NOTES:

Any Air Force authorized combination of utility uniform is authorized for wear at the Academy of Military Science, i.e. ABU. However, you must have ALL proper accessories for the uniforms you bring.

Three pairs of ABUs are recommended for use at AMS. Realizing that units are only authorized to issue two pairs, students will use their discretion whether to acquire the extra set or not. AMS will not replace uniforms damaged during training.
